- September 19<sup>th</sup>-21<sup>st</sup> Voting will begin at 8:00am on September 19<sup>th</sup> and conclude at 7:00pm on September 21<sup>st</sup>. The Political Affairs Chair will notify candidates of the election results individually by email after counting has taken place.
